- Coins are ordered only 1 time for the entire year (Spring, Summer and Fall graduations.)
- If Student Care is notified after a coin order has been placed, a fee will be assessed to offset the cost of obtaining older coins. If Student Care has trouble placing or obtaining older coins, the member will have to place their own order.
